Membership Playing Rights

The various playing rights for each Membership class are detailed as follows:

Full Members:

May play in all Championships, Cup events, Open Galas & Tournaments and Open Centre events, club days and participate in coaching activities. (This includes First Year Bowlers)

Limited Members:

May play in all club-day disc draws and participate in coaching activities. They cannot participate in Club Championships & cup events, or club or outside galas & tournaments.

Associated Members:

May play in any club galas & Tournaments as well as club-days. They can also participate in coaching activities. They cannot participate in club Championships or represent the club in outside/centre events.

Student Members:

Any person who is enrolled in a full time course of education at a school or tertiary institution, and who is under 19 years of age, may become a Student Member of the Club. Student Members shall have the same rights and privileges as Full Members.

All members within the above classes are entitled to practice on the club greens when available.

Social Members:

Use of the green in the evenings and other time for casual play when the green is not being used for Club or other events, including practices. No playing privileges to any club or external club/centre competition or event, except as provided specifically for casual bowlers.
